Charlotte specialised in legal issues of sustainable development and democracy in public economic law, constitutional law, and European law and has over 15 years of teaching, research and consulting experience. She is a world leading expert in trade agreements, with a particular interest in their role in sustainable value creation and in multi-level governance of democracy. Charlotte is the senior researcher of the SNSF Sinergia research project "Making Trade Agreements Work in the Service of Society" at the Centre for Trade and Economic Integration, Geneva Graduate Institute. She also holds the chair for international economic law, public economic law and sustainable development at Zurich Law School/Kalaidos FH and teaches international economic law at the University of Zurich and international environmental law at ZHAW. Her research has been the impetus for legal revisions in Switzerland on multiple occasions and has inspired the founding of the legal-tech company Besso (democratization of trade preferences).
